





Project Overview: New North Concourse Package #2B

- Scope of work includes temporary and permanent Air Operations Area (AOA) security fence, full
 demolition and removal of airfield pavements, surcharge and ground improvements, Passenger
 Boarding Bridge (PBB) foundation construction (for foundations in Package 2B limits), numerous
 aircraft parking layouts during various construction phases, utilities, new apron pavement
 construction and all incidentals necessary to complete the work in the contract documents.
- Utility work will include removal of abandoned domestic water lines, drain pipes, communications
 and electrical duct banks and sanitary sewer lines. Utility work will also include significant new
 utility infrastructure including a new dedicated fire service (DFS) line, new domestic water service
 for the New North Concourse (NNC), glycol collection system, storm drain collection system,
 oil/water separators, hydrant fueling system, provisions for potable water and replacement as well
 as relocation of a section of TV 150 power/communications duct banks.
- Security systems will be installed on the permanent AOA fence.

- All Subcontractors MUST be prequalified with Turner
- Bid Period: June 6, 2017 July 10, 2017
- Proposals and bids must be submitted via BuildingConnected

Virginia Contractor's License

- Virginia State Law requires anyone engaging in contracting work to obtain a Contractor's License from the Virginia Board for Contractors.

LDBE and M/WBE PARTICIPATION

- **LDBE** = Local Disadvantage Business Enterprise
 - Within a 100-mile radius of Washington, DC's Zero Mile Marker
 - Average annual gross receipts must not exceed the small business size standard
- LDBE Project Requirement: <u>25%</u>
- M/WBE = Minority and Women Business Enterprises
- M/WBE Project Goal: 15%

- Coordination with Airport work and activities

Program Specific Considerations

- Aviation Owner Controlled Insurance Program (OCIP) includes:
 - On-Site General and Excess Liability Insurance
 - Pollution Liability
 - Builder's Risk
- Subcontractor provided insurance must include:
 - Off-Site General and Excess Liability
 - Workman's Compensation Insurance (On and Off-Site)
- Construction Tradesman Minimum Wages Program

Turner Subcontract Components

- Form 36 VA (all subcontractors)
- Form 166 Purchase Contract (supply only contracts)
- Form 380 Professional Services Agreement (consultants)
- Applicable attachments:
 - AP-1 Statement of Work
 - AP-2 Contract Documents List
 - AP-3 Supplementary Provisions & Accelerated Payment Program Rider
 - AP-4 Logistics Plan
 - AP-5 Construction Tradesmen Minimum Wage Program
- Subcontractors/Vendors must agree to Turner's standard terms and conditions
